RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF A DUNAJEC RAFTING TRIP

- 1. Rafting trips are organised by the Polish Association of Pieniny Raftsmen.
- 2. Rafting is open daily from the 1st of April to the 31st of October except Easter Sunday and Corpus Christi.
- 3. Rafting does not take place if water levels exceed 250 cm.
- 4. The raftsmen are responsible for the safe transportation of passengers.
- 5. Passengers are obliged to follow the recommendations of the raftsmen that ensure their safety during a rafting trip, and adhere to the rules of visiting the Pieniny National Park, e.g. regarding the arrangement of passengers on the boat, maintaining silence in the Dunajec Gorge etc.
- 6. Persons under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants may not be transported. It is strictly forbidden to consume alcohol on the boat.
- 7. It is forbidden to pollute the river by dumping any waste or rubbish during the rafting trip.
- 8. Before the rafting trip begins, passengers may obtain life jackets from the raftsman.
- 9. Raftsmen are authorised to verify the age of children for whom discounted tickets were purchased; a document stating the child's date of birth is required.
- 10. Passengers are entitled to one piece of hand luggage under 5 kg, free of charge.
- 11. To transport any luggage over 5 kg, bicycles etc, passengers need to pay a fee according to the current price list.
- 12. A maximum of two bicycles, with no additional weight, such as panniers, can be taken on the boat, for an additional fee.
- 13. **The boats are not roofed**. Due to possible weather changes during the rafting trip, the passengers are required to carry appropriate clothing and protection from rain.
- 14. Tourists are advised to remain calm if small amounts of water enter the boat during rafting; such occurrence is normal and does not pose a threat to the safety of passengers.
- 15. The minimum number of passengers required for a boat to leave is 11. This applies to rafting trips to both Szczawnica and Krościenko. Rafting is also possible with a smaller number of passengers if the basic cost has been paid.
- 16. After purchasing tickets at the ticket office, passengers should make their way directly to the designated boat.
- 17. If, after purchasing tickets, tourists leave the marina, i.e. they don't immediately take a seat in the boat, their tickets are no longer valid. In such a case, they are not entitled to a refund of the cost of tickets.
- 18. Tourists who purchased their tickets online or at a ticket machine, are requested to scan them in the designated device or at a ticket office 15 minutes before the indicated time, and make their way to the designated boat.
- 19. If passengers wish to cancel their rafting trip after its departure from starting marinas, e.g. due to a change in the weather or alteration of plans, they are not entitled to a refund of the cost of tickets.
- 20. Passengers can return from final marinas by buses, for an additional fee. They can also rent a bicycle (for a fee) in order to return via the Pieniny Route.
 - *Buses run approximately every 40 minutes; the last one departs roughly 3 hours after ticket offices in the starting marinas of the Dunajec Rafting have closed.
 - *Return buses are located in:

Szczawnica – car park at ul. Pienińska 1

Krościenko — Main Square by the old church

- *Tourists who purchased the package "Rafting + PKL Palenica + bus" are picked up from the car park by the base station of the cable car, according to the timetable in the information leaflet.
- 21. Groups with a prior reservation are served according to the time in their reservation.
- 22. Purchasing a ticket for a Dunajec Rafting trip is tantamount to accepting these rules and regulations.
